Development of the Future Campus of Universitas Trisakti in Nagrak Region as a World Class, Sustainable Green Campus and Living Learning Community

BACKGROUND

In the fulfillment and implementation of its function as a university, Universitas Trisakti requires an integrated operational area. The integrated area is expected to accommodate academic and administrative activities within the scope of the University, Faculty, Technical Implementation Unit, extracurricular activities for students, and other activities that support University activities in general. The integrated area is also expected to encourage the improvement of the quality of Universitas Trisakti and support the achievement of the Vision, Mission, Goals and Objectives (VMTS) of Universitas Trisakti. Related to this, Universitas Trisakti will develop an integrated campus in a new location, designated as the future campus. CHAPTER I INTRODUCTION

A. BACKGROUND

Universitas Trisakti was established on November 29, 1965 as the only private university in Indonesia established by the Government of the Republic of Indonesia. Currently, Universitas Trisakti has 9 (nine) faculties, which include the Faculty of Law, Faculty of Economics, Faculty of Medicine, Faculty of Dentistry, Faculty of Civil Engineering and Planning, Faculty of Industrial Technology, Faculty of Earth and Energy Technology, Faculty of Landscape Architecture and Environmental Engineering, and Faculty of Fine Arts and Design, with a total of 30 (thirty) Undergraduate Programs and 5 (five) Diploma III Programs. In addition, there is a Postgraduate Program with 8 (eight) Master Programs and 2 (two) Doctoral Programs. All activities at Universitas Trisakti, be it education, management and development, are organized in several campuses located in Jabodetabek, with the largest on Campus A located in Grogol, West Jakarta. 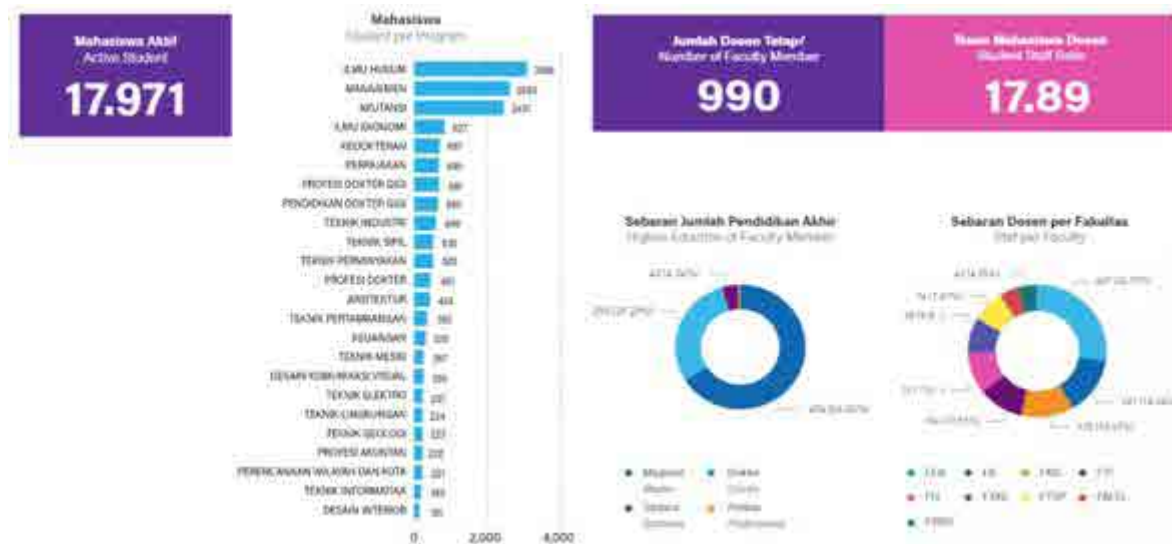


Figure 1. Profile of Universitas Trisakti’s students and lecturers (Universitas Trisakti Annual Report 2021-2022)

In fulfilling and carrying out its function as a higher education institution, Universitas Trisakti requires an integrated operational area. The integrated area is expected to accommodate academic and administrative activities both within the scope of the University, Faculty, Technical Implementation Unit, extracurricular activities for students, and other activities that support University activities in general. The integrated area is expected to encourage the improvement of the quality of Universitas Trisakti as a whole and support the achievement of the Vision, Mission, Goals and Objectives (VMTS) of Universitas Trisakti. The projection of master plan development of Universitas Trisakti’s Nagrak Campus on 2030 at least includes:

- 1) Student body of about 30,000 students;

- 2) over 1,000 lecturers and academic support staff;
- 3) a total of 55 study programs, 4) centralization in the management of administrative facilities and decentralization of academic disciplines.

Related to this, Universitas Trisakti will develop an integrated campus in a new location, designated as the future campus. The location is currently a 113-hectare of relatively undeveloped land in the Nagrak and Ciangsana areas, Gunung Putri District, Bogor Regency, West Java. The land has potential as a location of integrated campus with a landscape currently consisting of plantation, open fields and rainwater ponds. Previously in 2002, there was already a Master Plan for Universitas Trisakti in Nagrak and Ciangsana area, but it is now considered less relevant to the demands and needs of Universitas Trisakti today and in the future. Therefore, a regional planning is needed in the form of a Master Plan that can accommodate the needs of present and future Universitas Trisakti.

B. A PLAN FOR A COMPETITION FOR THE MASTER PLAN OF UNIVERSITAS TRISAKTI NAGRAK CAMPUS

With a rationale to meet the demands and needs of creating a conducive Universitas Trisakti Campus environment, in order to improve overall quality and achieve the vision, mission, and objectives of Universitas Trisakti, it is necessary to prepare a Master Plan for Universitas Trisakti Nagrak Campus.

The concepts and ideas of the Universitas Trisakti Nagrak Campus Master Plan are as follows:

- 1) Creating a future Usakti Campus that accommodates the Living Learning Community, by providing student dormitory facilities to facilitate the integration of learning activities with students' daily lives;
- 2) Design building masses that are functional, energy efficient, easy and cost-effective to maintain, integrated, inclusive and multifunctional;
- 3) Integrated land use, which is manifested through the harmony between building masses, as well as the harmony between buildings and the site environment;
- 4) Utilization of the site by providing outdoor spaces that are dynamic and can accommodate informal student activities;
- 5) Centralization in the management of administrative facilities and decentralization of academic disciplines;
- 6) Promote the appearance of a green urban environment in the entire campus area and display the image of a green campus;
- 7) Create a landmark as a unifying identity of Universitas Trisakti;
- 8) Respond to environmental issues and local development patterns.

Consideration of the design concept is as follows:

- 1) Functional, which directly and indirectly supports the implementation of the Three Pillars of Higher Education, namely education, research and community service activities;
- 2) Energy saving, in order to achieve the goal of Universitas Trisakti as a green campus with the highest ranking achievements on six categories (in reference to the 2022 UI Green Metric);
- 3) Low maintenance, ease of maintenance of buildings and supporting infrastructure;
- 4) Modernizing the campus environment with an architectural display that combines local and modern architectural content in an aesthetic form, while reflecting the character and image of higher education buildings;

- 5) Presenting cohesiveness between building masses and the site environment.

The plan for preparing the Master Plan of Universitas Trisakti Nagrak Campus includes:

- 1) Planning the building masses of all faculties, the rectorate, and other supporting facilities;
- 2) Integrated infrastructure planning within the campus that supports access for all users;
- 3) Planning an integrated and maintenance-friendly utility system within the campus area;
- 4) Landmark to show the identity of Universitas Trisakti campus;
- 5) Landscaping that is integrated with the outdoor layout, especially open spaces that accommodate student activities.

C. AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

Purpose:

The ideation of the Master Plan for Universitas Trisakti Nagrak Campus is intended to develop the Nagrak area as the Future and Integrated Campus of Universitas Trisakti that is comfortable and conducive in achieving the Trikrama of Universitas Trisakti and supporting the achievement of the vision, mission, goals and objectives of Universitas Trisakti.

Objectives:

The objectives of the ideation of the Master Plan for Universitas Trisakti Nagrak Campus are:

1. To produce an idea of Master Plan of Universitas Trisakti Nagrak Campus as an integrated campus that carries the concept of Green Urban Environment;
2. To realize the Future Universitas Trisakti Campus that accommodates the Living Learning Community;
3. To acquire ideas of innovative and iconic Master Plan of Universitas Trisakti Nagrak Campus by optimizing existing natural conditions and which can bring out the characteristics of Universitas Trisakti.

D. ORGANIZERS AND PARTICIPANTS

The Competition for Ideas on the Master Plan of Universitas Trisakti Nagrak Campus is organized by the Research and Community Service Institute (LPPM) of Universitas Trisakti via the Master Plan for Universitas Trisakti Nagrak Campus Task Force. This competition is open to the public, with the following participants:

CHAPTER II ABOUT THE COMPETITION

A. COMPETITION TITLE

“COMPETITION FOR IDEAS ON THE MASTER PLAN OF UNIVERSITAS TRISAKTI NAGRAK CAMPUS”

B. SCOPE OF THE COMPETITION

The competition is public and includes the arrangement of the education area and its facilities. Ideas expected from the participants include:

1. Master Plan concept or idea;
2. Overall planning of the area;
3. Land use/zoning plan;
4. Building layout plan;
5. Transportation/circulation plan;
6. Landscaping plan;
7. Utility network and maintenance plan;
8. Information system network plan.

C. LOCATION

This competition is located at the Universitas Trisakti Campus in Nagrak and Ciangsana, Gunung Putri District, Bogor Regency, West Java, with a site area of 113 Ha. The condition of the area is mostly undeveloped consisting of teak forests, former swamp areas where there are rainwater collection ponds, gardens, and grass fields that are used as soccer fields. Existing buildings in the form of houses and management/guard offices may be re-planned. However, part of this land has been allocated for the construction of a Teaching Hospital covering an area of approximately 5.5 hectares which has completed its design stage, so it must be taken into consideration in the preparation of the Master Plan. D. THE THEME (OBJECT) OF THE COMPETITION

The theme of this competition is **“Development of the Future Campus of Universitas Trisakti in Nagrak Region as a World Class, Sustainable Green Campus and Living Learning Community”**

The Master Plan idea must pay attention to the philosophical values and characteristics that reflect the global characteristics of Universitas Trisakti which also pays attention to the local values.

E. DESIGN CRITERIA FOR THE MASTER PLAN COMPETITION

1. Realizing the future Universitas Trisakti Campus as an Integrated Campus that accommodates the Living Learning Community;
2. Carrying the principle of Sustainable Development and Applying the concept of Green Urban Environment in the Master Plan of Universitas Trisakti Nagrak Campus;
3. Reflecting the Vision, Mission, and Goals of Universitas Trisakti;
4. Achieving the *Trikrama* of Universitas Trisakti;
5. Supporting the effective implementation of the Three Pillars of Higher Education;
6. Functional, energy-efficient, easy and cost-effective, integrated, inclusive and multifunctional building mass;
7. Ensuring coherence and integration of all building and unit functions (university/faculty/institute/bureau), including movement and connectivity;
8. Paying attention to inter-faculty integration with close functional and disciplinary relationships;
9. Development of Study Center Facilities, Business Incubator Center, Innovation Center, and Intellectual Property Rights Center, Community Empowerment Center, and Eco-Edu Park;
10. Taking into account the Public Transportation Mode Plan in and around the area;
11. Structuring building intensity and land use in accordance with university needs, local government regulations and regional development patterns;
12. Optimizing the potential of existing natural conditions (lakes, forests, open spaces);
13. Providing dynamic outdoor spaces to accommodate informal activities of the academic community;

14. Paying attention to connectivity between indoor and outdoor spaces that support the context; learning spaces/living labs and community interface between academic communities;
15. Paying attention to the image of Universitas Trisakti as the Campus of the Heroes of Reformasi;
16. Ensuring ease of access, comfort, safety and welfare of users;
17. Integrating the Master Plan of the Teaching Hospital building in the design;
18. Accommodating the 24-hour accessible campus facilities include a commercial center and community center in the Nagrak campus area;
19. Paying attention to the sustainable improvement of land ecology;
20. Paying attention to microclimate, issues of environmental quality degradation, Covid-19 pandemic that require strategic response/handling;
21. Paying attention to water management and conservation, solid and material waste management, pollution and mitigation against natural disasters;
22. Development of service networks such as integrated utility, communication, and information technology networks;
23. Paying attention to the connectivity between biodiversity, social diversity and geo-diversity in the making of an integrated campus area;
24. Providing continuous pedestrian paths throughout the campus area that ensure safe, comfortable and integrated accessibility with all campus facilities, including convenient accessibility for people with disabilities;
25. Landscaping the area by prioritizing biodiversity and applying the Sensory Garden concept that can provide a comfortable and pleasant impression for users.

F. PROGRAM NEEDS

The facilities needed in the Universitas Trisakti Nagrak campus area include (but are not limited to) the following:

1. Public/University Building Group
 - a) Rectorate Building;
 - b) Institution, Office, Technical Implementation Unit, and Bureau Buildings;
 - c) Center for Studies, Business Incubator Center, Innovation Center, Intellectual Property Center, Community Service Center;
 - d) Student Center, including Student Organizations and Student Activity Units;
 - e) Data Center/IT Center;
 - f) Central Library;
 - g) Auditorium and Meeting Rooms (which supports graduation, art performances);
 - h) Internationally standardized sports buildings and facilities, at least swimming pools, basketball courts, volleyball courts, badminton courts and soccer fields;
 - i) Teaching Hospital of Universitas Trisakti Nagrak Campus (existing);
 - j) Integrated Research Laboratory;
 - k) Integrated Innovation Product Design Workshop and Studio;
 - l) Religious Facilities;
 - m) Universitas Trisakti's Museum that describes the history of the establishment of Universitas Trisakti;
 - n) Faculty corner as a place to feature selected products from each faculty.

2. Building groups for 9 Faculties;
3. Student dormitories that support the Living Learning Community;
4. Supporting facilities such as Canteen/Cafeteria/Restaurant, Banking, Bookstore, Post Office/ Goods Delivery, Tax Center, MSME services, and other facilities that can be accessed 24 hours;
5. Supporting facilities in the form of learning spaces/living labs and community interfaces between academic communities that can be accessed 24 hours;
6. Open spaces, including open space for academic activities (in the form of Eco-Edu Park), *amphitheater*, green open space, blue open space, vehicle and pedestrian circulation space, and integrated parking area;
7. Gates, Landmarks, and signage system design elements;
8. Sustainable integrated Infrastructure, Transportation Systems and Utility Systems (responding to environmental issues and local development patterns).

G. PARTICIPANT REQUIREMENTS

Administrative requirements for participants include:

1. The competition is open to the public, lecturers, students and professionals;
2. Participants can be individuals or groups, consisting of a maximum of 5 (five) people including group leaders and members;
3. Participants will be disqualified, if:
 - They are proven to make any contact with the members of the Jury that affects the assessment process in any form during the selection process;
 - They reveal their identity in any form that will affect the judges' assessment process;
 - Their work is considered by the jury as a form of plagiarism or the work of others;
 - They do not meet administrative requirements.

H. TERMS OF COMPETITION MATERIAL

Participants who are members of a team are only allowed to submit 1 (one) work with a predetermined format containing 8 (eight) A1 portrait-sized panels with the following details:

1. The Macro Concept that provides the contextual and conceptual basis for the Nagrak Campus master plan;
2. The Micro Concept that contains details per zone of the area;
3. Plans containing the points in chapter II.B with provisions::
 - a. **Panel 1:** Analysis and Ideas for Regional Macro and Micro Concepts;
 - b. **Panel 2:** Area Master Plan and Land Use;
 - c. **Panel 3-7:** Ideas and Plans for Architecture, Infrastructure, Landscaping, Utilities, and Information Systems;
 - d. **Panel 8:** 3-Dimensional Visualization/Impression.
4. Participants notice and consider the font type and size to be legible if the A1 panel is reduced to A2 size;
5. The image layout for each panel is made freely by including a letterhead (**attached**) and still paying attention to the proper display of information and easy to read;
6. The only identifier on the panel of works is the participant number submitted after registration;
7. For 5 (five) participants who are selected to take part in Second Stage of Judging (presentation

evaluation), they are required to also present their work in the form of a presentation and animation video with a maximum duration of 3 (three) minutes.

I. STATUS OF THE COMPETITION MATERIALS

The winning material of the competition and the “Economical Copyright” of the winning work become the property of the organizer, namely: **Universitas Trisakti** (The form is attached in **Appendix IX.**)

Copyright and Intellectual Property Rights of all works in this competition belongs to Universitas Trisakti as the organizer of the competition and can be used for the benefit of Universitas Trisakti.

For participants whose design will be used or continued until it is built, the winner’s involvement in developing the design will be arranged with Universitas Trisakti outside of this competition.


